

CASE STUDY:

HENSHAWS TAKES DELIVERY OF 3 NEW TEREX FINLAY 883 HEAVY DUTY SCREENERS

SITUATION:

Innovative waste management company, Henshaws has grown from a small skip business, to become one of the largest and most dynamic waste recycling operators in the North West region.

Founded by Joe Henshaw, who is now the managing director of Henshaws, the company has shown year-on-year growth across more than 20 years of trading and employs 50 people. It has a wide-ranging customer base, including blue chip companies, construction sites, the public sector and householders.

SOLUTION:

Finlay Plant North West - part of the Finlay Group of companies - has supplied three Terex Finlay 883 reclaimers to help keep Henshaws, of Macclesfield, Cheshire, on the business growth curve to 90 per cent.

Plant North West has already enabled Henshaws to increase their recycling rate. This latest version comes with longer conveyors, which will further enhance stock-piling capability and enable the company to recycle even more waste. The 883 has transformed Henshaws'



operations. It will work all year round, and is capable of dealing with waste direct from the skip. Recycling soil, bricks and hardcore, the machine produces 10mm top soil, crush and run, and oversized material for crushing. Henshaws have also been able to reduce the amount of fines going to landfill, due to the top deck of the machine being fitted with heavy duty tines.

OUTCOME:

Joe Henshaw, MD of Henshaws, said: "We have been working with Finlay Group for more than 15 years, and they've been on hand to offer the machinery we need to grow the business.

"It is important for us to have a supplier with same day service and spares back-up, so that is why we keep with Finlay Plant."

The Finlay 883 works as an aggregate screener after a primary crusher, or on its own as a frontline screening machine. Applications include quarry waste, construction and demolition debris, top soil and aggregates. Processing at a rate of up to 500 tonnes per hour, the key to the 883's success is its adaptability, whatever the application or industry.
